What office and district are you a candidate for?

1. Do you have a connection to the arts? If so, please share.

Yes. My father Gaston Duigou was a graduate of the Yale University School of Art in the late 1940s. He taught Art Class at the Taft School in Watertown, CT after graduation from Yale. Eventually he was employed at Pratt & Whitney Aircraft developing/drafting engine repair manuals for the military. Our family possesses his artwork from his student and post graduate work.

2. Can you share an arts experience that has impacted your life or the lives of your family members?

After I graduated from UCONN, I worked as a research assistant at the UCONN Marine Science Institute and befriended an Assistant Professor of Physical Oceanography from Odessa, Ukraine. He possessed some Soviet Era artwork which he shared with me at a dinner at his home here in CT. I was impressed with the diverse style of artwork he possessed which reflected the suppressed lifestyle/freedoms in the communist state.
