1. Do you have a connection to the arts? If so, please share.

2. Can you share an arts experience that has impacted your life or the lives of your family members?

4. Studies have shown that arts and culture can deliver a 3 to 1 return on investment at a minimum if adequately funded. Despite this, Connecticut has historically under

invested state funds in the arts and lags the rest of the nation in recognizing that arts generate tax revenue and support a thriving economy.

If elected (or re-elected), will you support increased investment of state funds in arts and culture?

Yes. For every dollar we invest in the arts and culture we get multiple dollars back in return. These investments are economic drivers for our state.

5. Are there any other ways that you'd like to convey to voters how you have been supportive of the arts?

As the House Bonding Chairman - I put an additional \$10M in the DECD Good to Great Grant that is for upgrades to museums. As legislator, I will continue to be an advocate for the investments in arts, culture and tourism.
